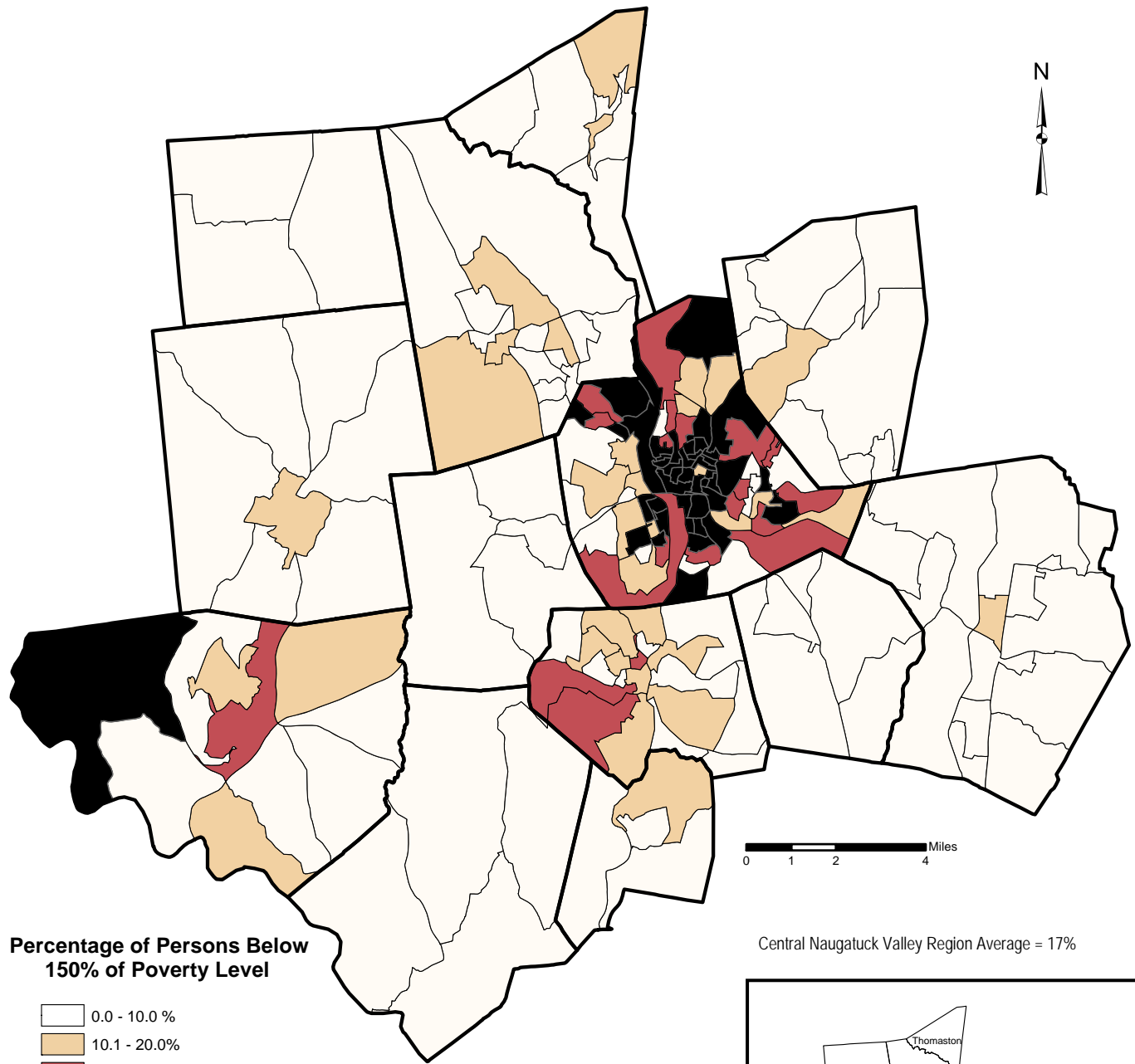


Persons Below 150% of Poverty Level: 2009
