**STRATEGIC HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN**

The general goals of the *State of Connecticut Highway Safety Plan: Federal Fiscal Year 2007* are:

- To significantly reduce the number of alcohol-related crashes.
- To reduce the number of hazardous moving violations and speed related crashes.
- To increase safety belt use rates and remain at a level that is consistently above the national average.
- To continue to reduce the number of serious injury crashes occurring in construction/work zone areas.
- To reduce the number of injuries and deaths among motorcycle operators and passengers.
- To develop a delivery system that provides users with timely, complete, and accurate traffic records data.
- To improve safety and highway operations of the State's roadways.
- To reduce the number of all crashes to levels consistently below the national average.
